DEFINITIONS:

- C** Yes
- II** "ERROR" used by most CW OPS instead of 8 dits
- MCA** Morse Code Academy
- MGN** CVARC, MORSE Group Net
- N** No
- NCS** Net Control Station
- OP** Operator
- QND** This net is directed. Transmit only when invited by the NCS.
- QNF** The Net is Free (not controlled).
- QNI** Means "Check-in", and "TNX QNI" means thanks for checking-in. QNI sent after the NCS's call sign is an invitation to check in.
- QNS** List of check-in stations
- QRU** Have you anything for me?
- QSP** Any relays? Will you relay to _____?
- QST** Something of general interest to hams follows. It explains to the casual bystander what's going on while establishing your presence to members waiting to check in.
- R** Roger, received
- Rx** (not being used at this time)
This is new but is getting popular in other CW nets. X is a number from 1 to 5 indicating how well we were receiving that transmission. Replaces the RST report.
- R5** Got it all
- R4** Got it all but with some difficulty
- R3** Difficult copy, and I may have missed or didn't get some of what you said.
- R2** I am missing most of what you are saying
- R1** No copy, but I can hear you in there.
- <AR>** Prosign for end of message.
- <SK>** Prosign for end of contact
- TOAKS** Thousand Oaks
